

## **Description of specialties**

Studies in the area of Modern Real Estate Management provide the candidate with interdisciplinary knowledge and skills in the field of spatial management, with special emphasis on real estate management.

The offered courses enable the candidate to gradually develop his/her skills in the area of real estate management. The curriculum includes: general and introductory courses, specialist courses modeling the future real estate manager's profile (territorial marketing, spatial management and environmental protection, regional policy, real estate management), occupational training courses - preparing the graduate to perform the job of real estate manager (real estate management, financial consultancy, cost-effectiveness analyses of real estate investment projects). Students are required to submit a master's degree thesis.

Upon the completion of the relevant vocational training, the graduate is entitled to apply for a professional license of real estate manager.

Studies in the area of Modern Real Estate Management prepare the graduate for employment in central and local administration units, real estate management and investment companies, development agencies, consulting companies and providers of business-support services in the area of spatial management, research institutions, research and development centers.
